2. Operations:

a. <u>Personnel</u>:

I am going to start training and instructing with East Side Fire. I have a meeting set up with the Fire Chief next week to discuss volunteer retention and ways to improve our current system.

- b. Early Projects: Getting ready for Wildland season and Hydrant testing,
- c. <u>Equipment:</u> On 02/20/2022 T260 had significant damage happen to the passenger door. T260 hit the side of the bay door while the vehicle was in motion.
- d. <u>Fire Prevention/Inspections:</u> MKI has had a total of 6 inspections from January 25th February 22nd.
- e. Policies: Were emailed and awaiting approval.
- f. Public Relations I organized the 2022 North Idaho First Responders Fit Challenge competition. I have full support and assistance from CDAFD and KCFR. We will have 8 local gyms involved with multiple boot camps and prizes. MKI has received a lot of compliments and handshakes regarding this event. The community is very excited to participate with this event. This is a great opportunity for MKI to recruit and put us on the eyes of every local department.

<u>Driver Operator Class NFPA 1002 –</u> I submitted the application to the state, and I will receiving free materials from the state. The date of the class is TBD, I am going to invite WFD, CDAFD and KCFR. I am going to have ten seats available for students. I have a CDAFD Captain wanting to help teach the class and a LT from Worley that wants to assist.

<u>CPR Class</u> – I need to teach one class and I will be certified to start teaching American Heart Association CPR. KCFR will let me use the materials to teach class.

4. Projects:

- a. <u>Decks:</u> Waiting for the weather to allow project to continue. Once we are able, we will be getting holes dug and we will set the decks.
- b. New Smokey the Bear Sign: Roughly 6-8 weeks we will have a new sign with our log on the sign. IDL is going to have it made and install it, we will have an outreach type ceremony when its installed so we can educate the pubic. We will be receiving two signs we have to make the supports for them.
- c. <u>Run Cards-</u> They have been updated and are 90% completed, We originally had 45 run cards for 3 zones. We have a total of 6 zones which each zone should have 225 runs.
